Dear Patient,



I hope this letter finds you in good health. I am writing to inform you of changes I am making to my dermatology practice at eOs Dermatology.

As you know, eOs Dermatology is a part of Austin Regional Clinic, a multi-specialty medical group with 17 locations in Central Texas. At ARC, we aim to provide easy access to medical care where the need is the greatest. As my practice at eOs Dermatology has grown, so has the Greater Austin Area resulting in increased demand for medical services at ARC.

After much consideration about how to best meet the demands of a growing community and still serve my current patients, I have decided to relocate my practice to ARC Southwest at 1807 W Slaughter Ln., Austin, TX 78748 (see map on back). We are building a brand new space designed for my dermatology practice, inside our current clinic, and are excited about the move.

When I move to ARC Southwest, I will no longer use the eOs Dermatology name, location, or web site. What that means to you is that I will practice only at ARC Southwest, all communications from me will come from ARC, and you can find information about my services and request appointments online at [AustinRegionalClinic.com](http://AustinRegionalClinic.com). Essentially, I will continue running my practice just like I always have, only in a new office.

My last day at eOs Dermatology will be May 3, 2013. I will begin seeing patients at my new office on May 6, 2013. As of May 6<sup>th</sup>, you may call ARC Southwest at (512) 282-8967 to make appointments. If you are receiving this letter and you are not a regular patient of mine, your care at Austin Regional Clinic will not change.

Happily, I will continue to offer cosmetic dermatology services that I perform personally such as Botox, fillers, laser resurfacing, and sclerotherapy. You can also continue to purchase your skin care products from my new office. With much consideration and weighing all the pros and cons, there will be two major changes resulting from this move.

- We will no longer offer aesthetician services like facials or waxing.
- We will discontinue the sale and redemption of gift cards.

I hope to continue to care for your medical, surgical, and cosmetic skin care needs at ARC Southwest. My staff and I look forward to providing you the same level of service in our new space. Once you see our new office, I think you will be as excited as we are about this move. It is an honor and a privilege to have you as a patient.
