With ongoing outbreaks of diseases, such as measles in communities that have low immunization rates, we've seen how quickly illness can spread, especially to young infants and the elderly population. The goal of our vaccine policy is to ensure our clinics do not pose health risks for our most high-risk patients.

We are committed to providing you with accurate and up-to-date information about vaccines while creating a safe and informed space where we can discuss your questions and concerns.

Advising vaccination for all pediatric patients

ARC doctors strongly recommend vaccinations for all pediatric patients. We request immunization records for all our pediatric patients. To help us protect our highest-risk patients, we encourage our families who choose not to vaccinate to talk with their child's doctor about immunization questions or concerns. Your child's doctor can update you on recommended vaccinations and work with you on a vaccine catch-up schedule.
